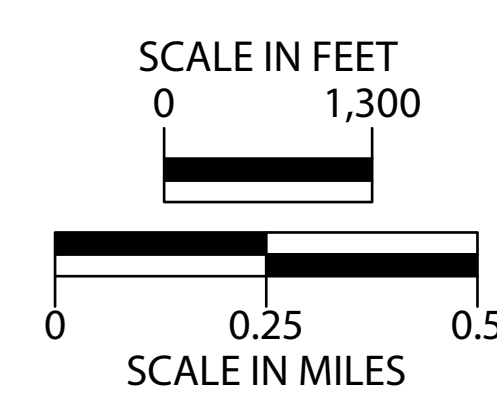

This map generally omits public facilities that are shown or listed in other Comprehensive Plan elements, such as parks, recycling centers, transportation networks, and water, sewer, and stormwater infrastructure and networks. The maps also omits publicly-owned land that does not include a public facility (existing, under construction, or funded).

Parks are shown on this map for information purposes only. An inventory of public parks can be found in the Public Spaces Master Plan.
